


Annual Medicaid Renewal Timeline

The State of Georgia will check every 12 months to see if you're still eligible for Medicaid coverage. Take charge by marking dates in your calendar and following these steps.

WHAT TO DO TODAY:

Confirm your contact info at gateway.ga.gov and get your renewal date.
